Dr. Keith R. Britton G., MD, PhD., Panamá, is a Radiation Oncologist (2005), currently the Medical Director of CIRRO Cancer center (Panamá) with a dilated experience in entrepreneurship, volunteering and planning innovative initiatives for transformation in social health.

He obtained the title of Medical Doctor from the Autonomous University of Central America (UACA), San José, Costa Rica (1991-1997), Specialist in Radiation Oncology, The University of Tohoku, Sendai, Japan (2005) and Post – Clinical Post-Doctorate in High Radiation Technologies, The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center, Houston, Texas, USA (2007).



Founder and current Director of the International Center for Radiosurgery and Radiotherapy Oncology, CIRRO, dedicated to the comprehensive management of patients with Cancer and former President of the Panamá National Cancer Association (ANCEC), dedicated to the promotion and prevention of Cancer in children and adults in the country.

In the field of Oncology, Dr. Britton has received multiple awards including the Junior Investigator award (JRS, Japan), Berlex-Oncology clinical translational award (MDACC, USA), SNO scholarship award (American Neuro-oncology Society), USA, among others.

Internationally, dr Britton has served as consultant / expert / official mission project manager for the IAEA (Intl.
