

Biography Dr Efrain Cambronero



Dr Efrain Cambronero Moraga is a surgical oncologist with more than 30 years of experience in the field. He is one of the Comprehensive Center of Oncology's (CCO) founders at the Momentum Medical Center in Escazu, San Jose. Dr Cambronero obtained his medical degree at the University of Costa Rica School of Medicine in 1984 and completed his surgical oncology residency in 1990.

After passing the ECFMG he pursued further training in the United States where he did an additional surgical oncology fellowship at the University of Chicago supported by The Audrey Meyer Mars International Fellowship of the American Cancer Society focused on breast cancer, gastrointestinal cancer and skin cancer (1994 - 1995).

He did a second fellowship in head and neck oncologic surgery at the University of Miami (1995 – 1997) where he received the first prize at the Chandler Society of Residents and Fellows Scientific Forum.

Therefore, the areas in which Dr Cambronero has the most experience and interest are head and neck cancer with emphasis on thyroid cancer, breast cancer, gastrointestinal cancer and skin cancer, including melanoma.

Dr Cambronero is an active member of the Society of Surgical Oncology (SSO), the AHPBA (Americas Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary Association), the IHPBA (International Hepato-Pancreato Biliary Association) in which he has served on their international relationship committees. Dr Cambronero is also an active international member of the American Head and Neck Society (AHNS) and Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS).

Finally, Dr Cambronero has published papers in national and international medical journals as well as presented several posters and oral discussions in medical meetings.
