Soraya Verstraeten is the quality manager of the Caribbean Prevention Center (Fundashon Prevenshon) in Curaçao and an Assistant Professor at the Erasmus School of Health Policy and Management in Rotterdam. She holds a bachelor's degree in molecular biology (cum laude), a master's degree in biomedical sciences and a PhD-degree in public health. Her work has been published in among others the American Journal of Public Health, the European Journal of Public Health, Social Science & Medicine and the Dutch Medical Journal (Nederlands Tijdschrift voor Geneeskunde). As the principal investigator, she has led several health studies in Curaçao, among others the national health surveys of 2013 and 2017 and the 2015 youth health survey, at the



Institute of Public Health (Volksgezondheid Instituut Curaçao), which she co-founded in 2012. Dr. Verstraeten serves as a member of the Scientific Committee of the Netherlands Society for Tropical Medicine and International Health and the Asosiashon Mediko di Antias, and is the chairwomen of the Kaya Kaya Foundation.
